year grant intended to support basic and translational early career researchers in hematology, allowing them to test a high-risk but potentially high impact idea that is lacking solid preliminary data, and is therefore too premature to submit for regular funding.

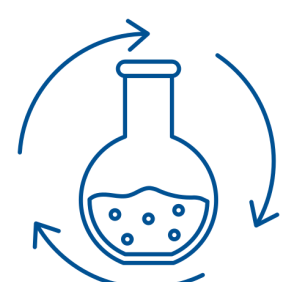
Eligibility



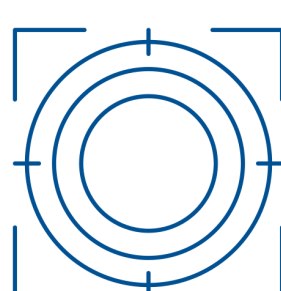
Basic and translational lab-based researchers in hematology,



Up to eight years post PhD graduation; exceptions must be justified,



PhD students in the final year of their PhD study. They must provide proof of an academic host lab where the research will be performed,



MDs with a keen interest in pursuing a career in research, up to eight years after MD graduation or up to eight years after PhD graduation, whichever came last. Exceptions must be justified,



The host institute must be an academic research center or a proven equivalent in Europe.

Max €2000 for attendance of EHA congress during the project year.

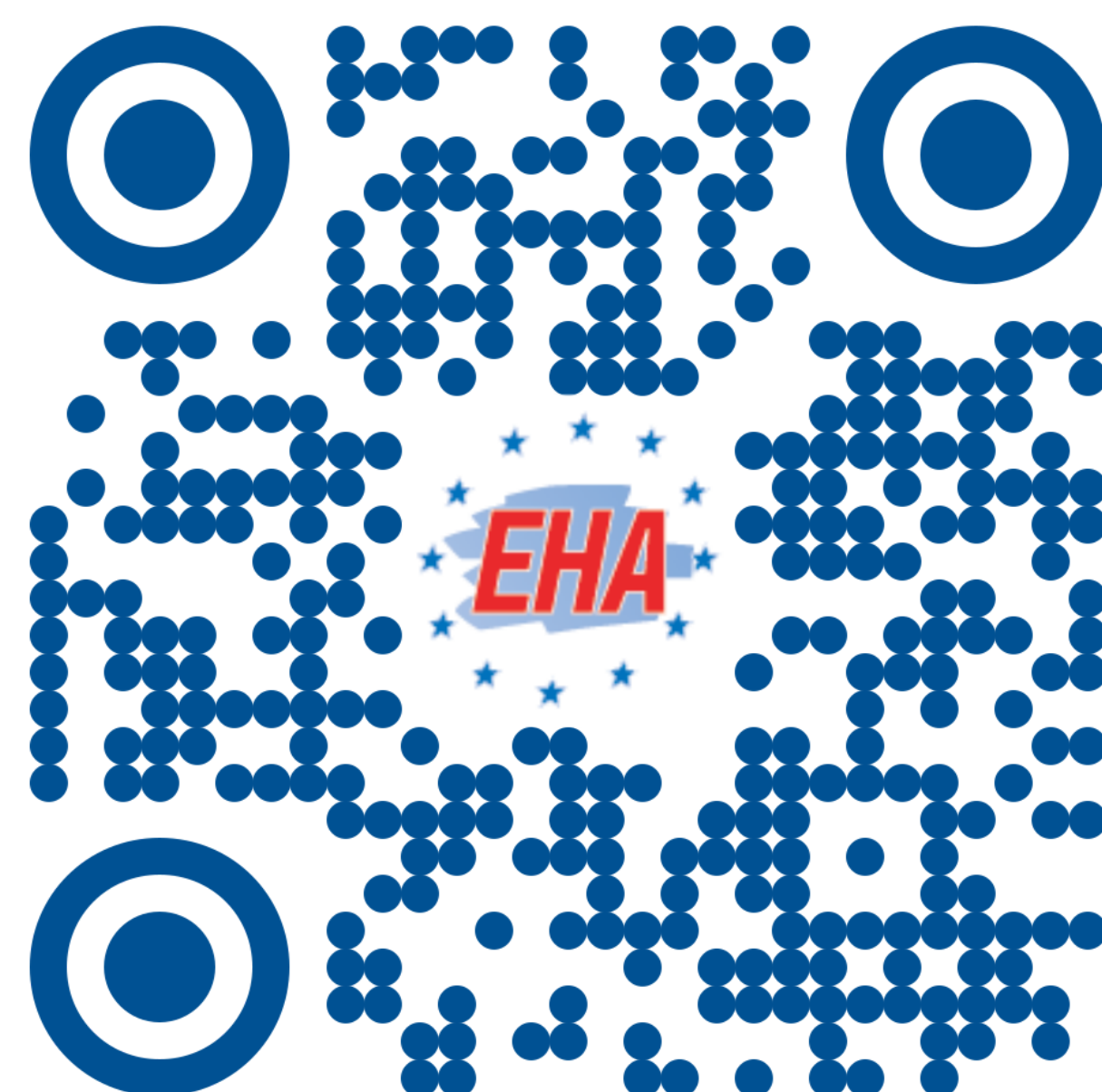
